Dear Members and Friends:



PURPOSE

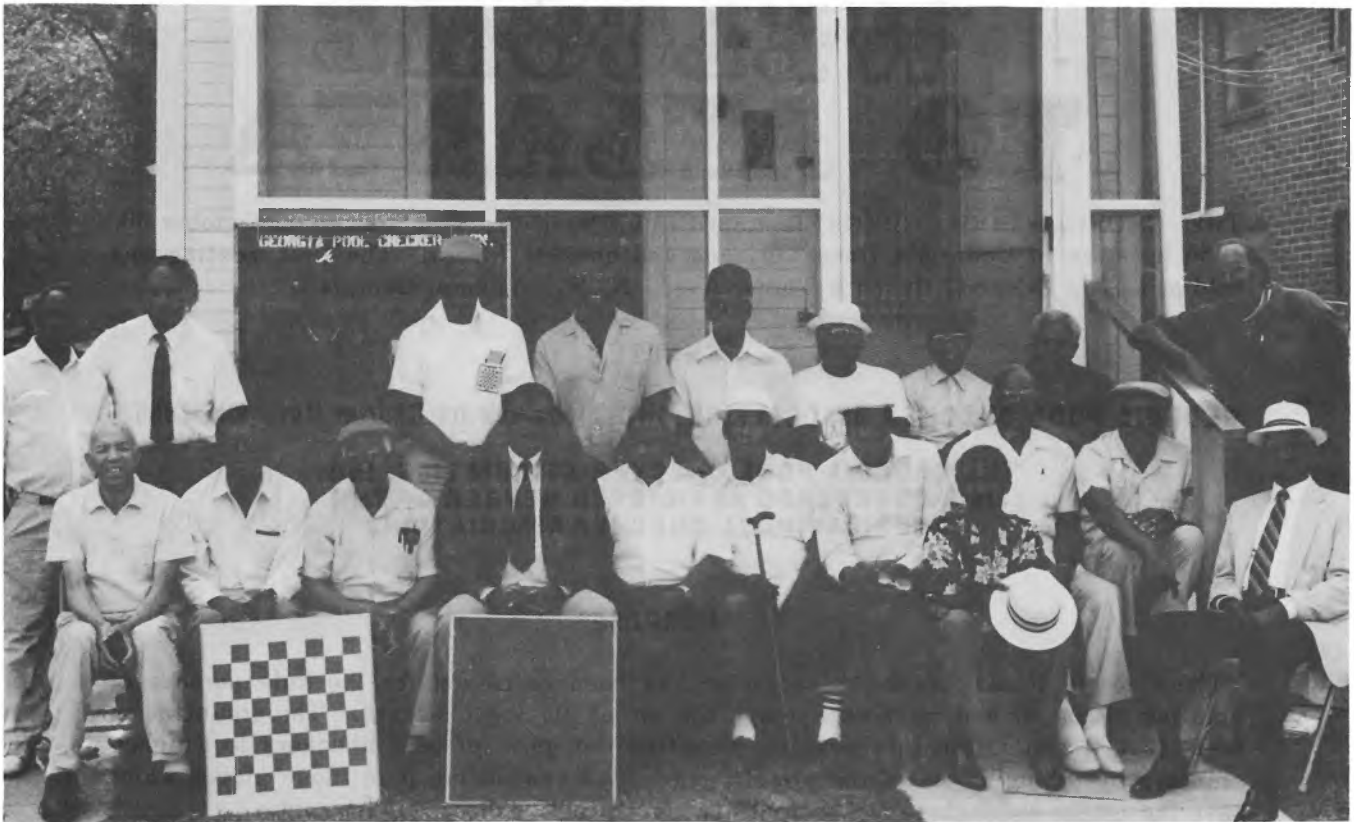

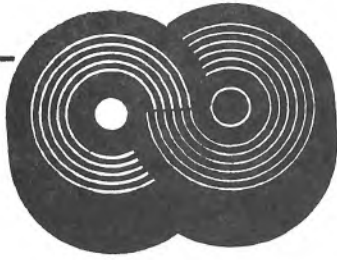

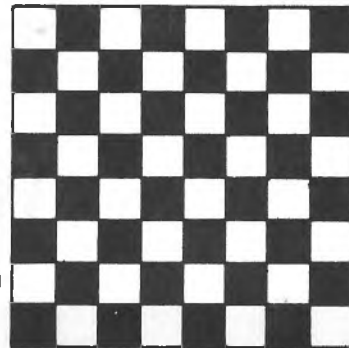
